SAFETY AND BARN RULES

- Young children must be supervised.
- Never enter a stall without permission and never enter a paddock with horses in it, unless you have been properly trained on how to catch/ turn out a horse.
- If you are unsure of what you are doing, ask for help.
- All riding and horse handling is done at your own risk.
- Never stand behind or go under a horse.
- No bare feet or sandals are allowed around horses at any time, by anyone.
- Horses are not to be left unattended while tied to a fence or at the washing area.
- Clean up after yourself and/or your horse. This includes common areas, such as wash stalls.
- No horseplay at the barn. This includes running, shouting, throwing projectiles (rocks, dirt, clods, etc.), waving objects, wrestling, climbing fences/gates, fighting and chasing.
- Guest of students (parents, siblings, and friends) are asked not to enter arenas, turn-outs, or stalls and remain a respectful distance from the horses, when they are being moved outside of these.
- If you borrow something please return the item to where it belongs.
- Keep all barn and arena gates closed at all times.
- Absolutely no smoking or open flames is permitted in the barn, or anywhere on the premises.
- No abusive, threatening, or violent behavior towards people or animals will be tolerated on the premises.
